F & P T are new to London Borough of Barking and Dagenham and have been offered a grant to set up this service locally. Friends and Places have been working in various areas since 2012 and have helped 80 friendships and families have a break in their caring role This offers disabled young

F & P T can help with recruiting staff by matching **skills and interest** with **friendships.** A number of families **share the cost** of support with other families so that funds go further, for example, if 2 friends go to drama together with only 1 carer. This was with agreement with both families. All staff recruited aim to support friendships and are encouraged to have, 1, 2 or 3 friends in the community depending on needs.

Is there a Cost?

There is **no cost** for friends and places' input, but there is a cost for any expenses occurred if friends are going out in the community using a volunteer from F & P T, e.g going out for dinner with a friend. F & P T usually **set up agreed** amount for activities. F & P T is a not for profit organisation and any funds reserved are used to expand services offered to young people.
